ENGLISH LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT AND DIGITAL SKILLS FOR TEACHERS AND STAFF WORKING IN SCHOOLS

A1/A2

Course summary

This course is for teachers and other staff working in schools who wish to improve their English language skills and enhance their fluency. Participants will take part in discussions, pair-work and group work activities in the classroom. The afternoon lessons focus on conversation and allow participants to develop the key skills necessary for effective communication. One afternoon session will be a workshop dedicated to enhancing digital skills for use in the classroom. An interactive communicative approach is applied. This provides participants with their own experiential learning through activities and methodologies presented. This course is eligible for Erasmus plus funding.

Preparation

The course is aimed at A1 (Elementary) to A2 (Pre-intermediate) participants. Participants will be asked to fill in an application form and will receive a web link to our online placement test which is to be completed before the starting date of the course.

Key topics

- Language awareness: Introduction and revision of new vocabulary and grammar
- Phonology: Practice of pronunciation, intonation and stress
- Communication: Building confidence when speaking in English

Objectives

By the end of the course, participants will have:

- Improved their four language skills; speaking, listening, writing and reading.
- Improved their knowledge and understanding of English grammar.
- Gained confidence and fluency when communicating in English
