# PUBLIC TRANSPORT

To use public transport in Malta, you will need a bus card. We recommend the Explore Flex Card - this costs €6.00 and you can link it to the 'tallinja' app on your phone so you can top-up your card at any time. It can be bought from the Tallinja Help Desk at the airport in the arrivals section, or from the bus terminus in Valletta.

The bus card also allows you to use other services such as the Tallinja Bikes, the Gozo Fast Ferry, the Night Bus services and the Valletta Ferry services.

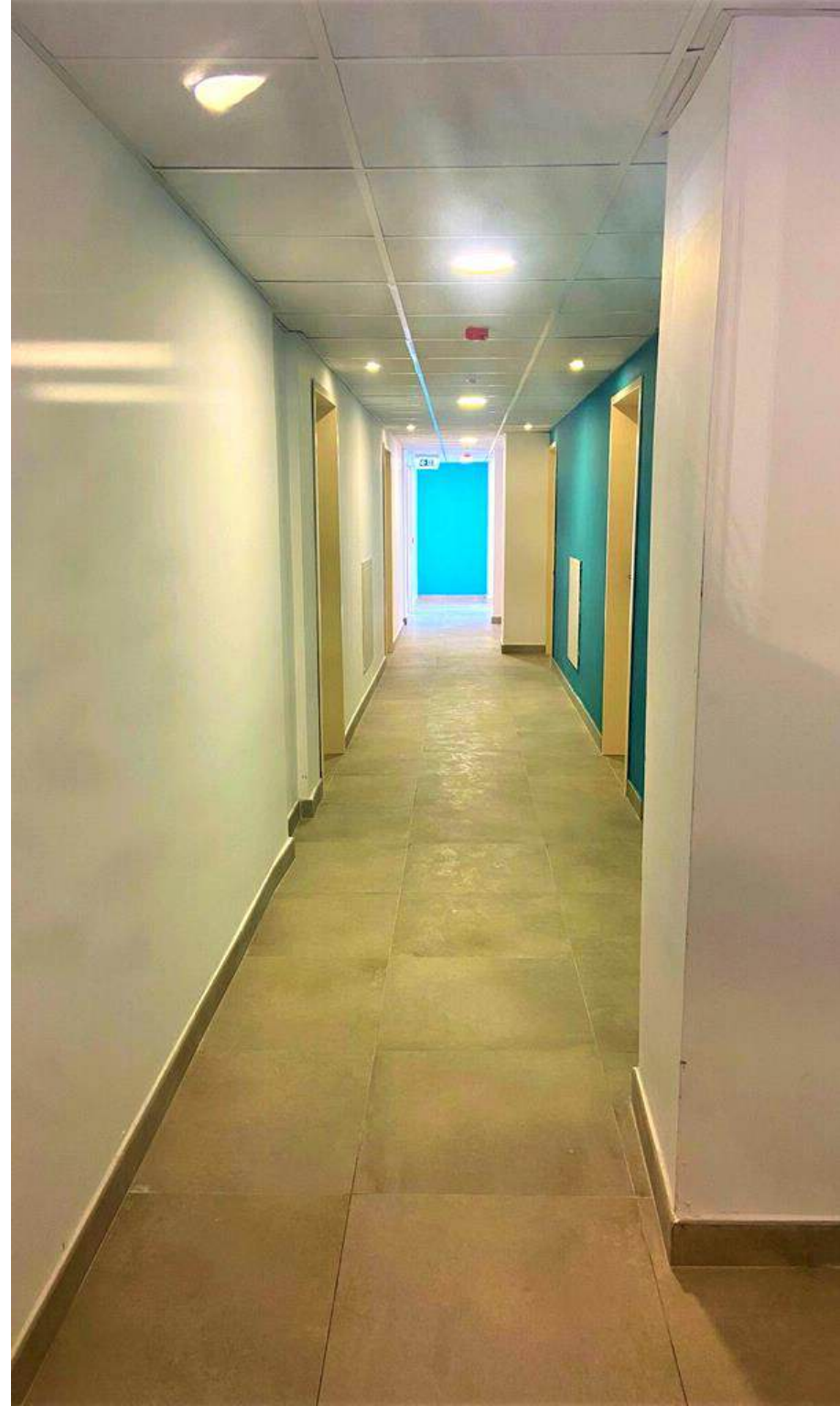
